Duties: The Sr. AIX Engineer at American Greetings Corporation in Cleveland, Ohio provides 24/7 technical support for a large enterprise-wide Unix/AIX server environment including daily AIX administration, problem determination and resolution, and support of a highly virtualized environment. He or she plans, designs, and implements multiple internal infrastructure projects as well as provides day-to-day assistance for system administration, operational support, and problem resolution to the Unix Engineering and Support Team. The Sr. AIX Engineer is responsible for leading the overall management enterprise infrastructure, which includes but is not limited to the following applications: Tivoli Storage Manager, HMC, VIOS and V-SCSI and NPIV. Advanced use of all network configurations that comprise the enterprise application portfolio is expected. The Sr. AIX Engineer identifies opportunities and implements process improvements based on automation or elimination of unnecessary administration; develops and implements scripts to streamline ongoing management of the AIX environment; and works closely with the service delivery and automation team to integrate AIX processes into automated workflows. He or she establishes standards and best practices for process, documentation, AIX security and operational improvements to be used by the AIX team. Responsibilities also include AIX and 3rd party software upgrades including planning, design, and implementation, as well as performance troubleshooting and analysis. The Sr. AIX Engineer drives usage and adoption of advanced virtualization technologies provided by Power VM Virtualization and Power 5, 6, and 7 hardware as well as Power 7 Flex system hardware, and AIX Enterprise Edition including active memory virtualization, live partition mobility, and WPARs. Remaining current on the latest technology as new versions of Power hardware and AIX software are released is expected. He or she designs and implements pSeries technologies. The Sr. AIX Engineer works with technical and business partners in a fast-paced, high pressure environment across various infrastructure and application organizations to deliver projects. He or she delivers operational support and engineering direction on series hardware design including VIOS, network, storage, and workload balancing; provides technical design along with hardware and labor estimates to support projects; takes part in installation and offers ongoing support for IBM Tivoli products. The Sr. AIX Engineer must be available on-call to respond to emergency situations as they arise outside of normal working hours. The Sr. AIX Engineer must be supporting CA Technologies Workload Automation AE in with UNIX servers. The Sr. AIX Engineer installs, configures and performs troubleshooting of High Availability Clusters HACMP.
